Girl Scout program fees include admission to the core exhibition, special exhibition galleries, and the **Textile Learning Center (TLC)**.

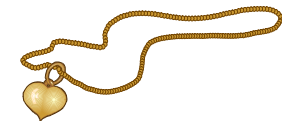

Fees

- Fees range from \$5-10 /per scout depending on program.
- Minimum cost is \$60/group (\$50 for Daisies) counting participating scouts.
- Payment is made upon arrival at the Museum.
- Fee includes general Museum admission.
- No charge for 1 adult per group.

General Museum Admission

- \$8 for adults 17 and over
- \$6 for children 6-16, seniors, and students with i.d.
- Free for children under 6.
- Free for Museum members.
- Group rates available.

Directions

- The Museum, adjacent to Lowell's National Historical Park, is located 35 miles north of Boston.
- Take Route 495 North or South to the Lowell Connector ---(exit 35C.)
- Take the Lowell Connector to exit 5B (Thorndike Street)
- Follow Thorndike Street through four sets of traffic lights.
- Bear right at 4th traffic light onto Dutton Street.
- Museum entrance and parking lot will be on your left. Red brick building with green and yellow banners.

Parking

Free parking in the Museum's parking lot just outside of the building.
